COMMUNITY: We are located in Fulton County in South Central Pennsylvania, which is part of the Appalachian region. Our town is composed of a large industry, a medical center, many small businesses and numerous family farming operations.

SCHOOL: The high school offers approximately 80 courses including advanced placement, academic, vocational business, technical, distant learning programs, and college courses in conjunction with Allegany College of Maryland and Pennsylvania State University. McConnellsburg High School is accredited by the Pennsylvania Department of Public Instruction.

ENROLLMENT: Total Enrollment: 255 - Grade 12-57; Grade 11-54; Grade 10-66; and Grade 9-78

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS: In grades 9 through 12 every student shall obtain at least 24 units of credit: 4 English, 4 Mathematics, 4 Science, 4 Social Studies, 2 Arts or Humanities, 1 Health & Physical Education, and 4.5 Electives. Also, each student must complete a professional portfolio, 24 community service hours, and a senior class project. In addition, all students must obtain Proficient or better on the PSSA test, in addition to all other requirements to receive a diploma.
